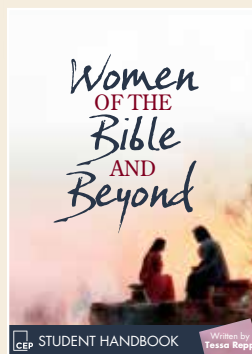

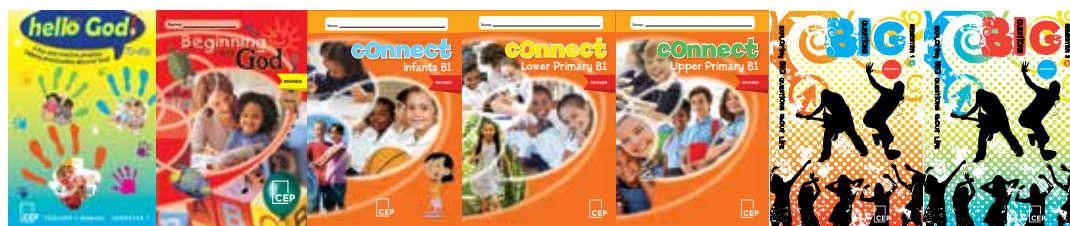

Hello God!

The Teacher’s pack includes a manual full of detailed preparation notes, 20 colour posters, lesson aims and outcomes, and age-appropriate songs and movement music.



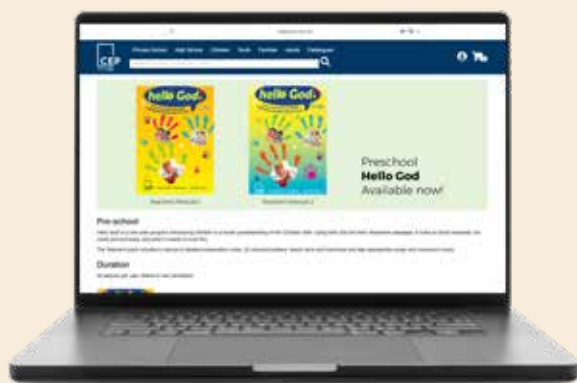

The Visual aid pack features 18 posters of the biblical events, characters and stories covered in the lessons. Also included are digitised versions of all images.

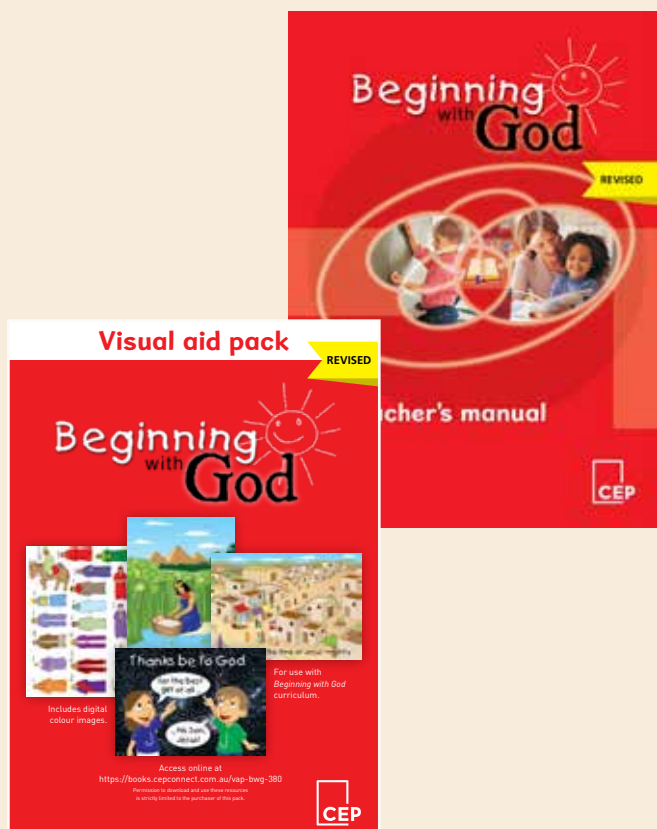

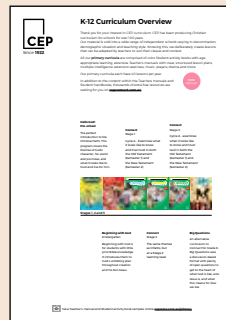
